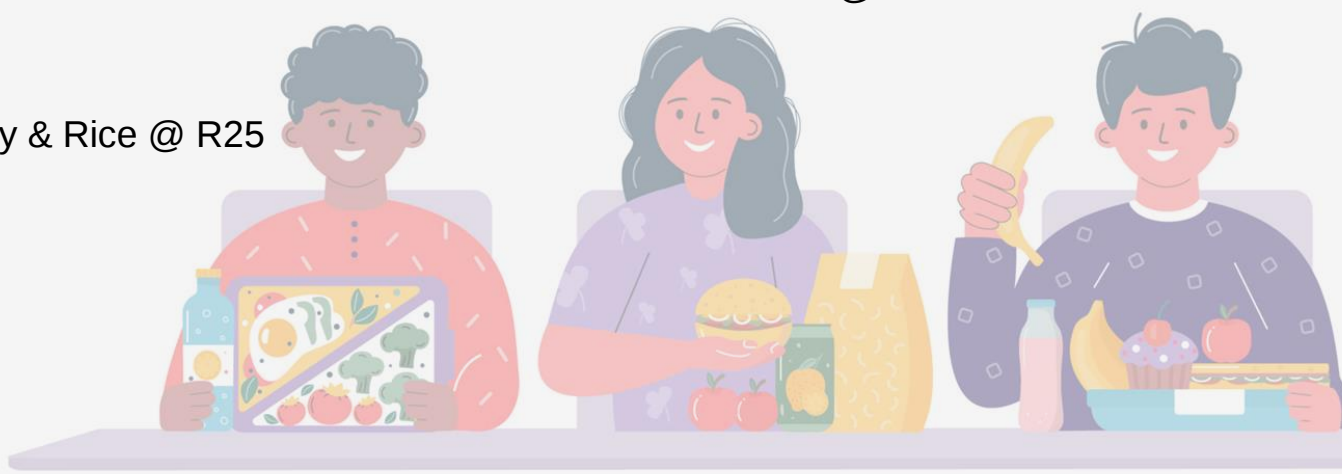

A reader and scribe are someone that assists a learner during an assessment. Some learners require their assessments read to them; others require someone to write the assessment for them.

What qualifications do you need?

You must be able to read well and write eligibly. Patience will also be needed. The Department of Education has a free course that must be completed to receive the necessary certificate that allows you to accommodate these learners.
